When faced with temptation, consider first...

I. The Judgement of God

- A. Look ahead and see what sin brings
- B. Sin as a process:
 - 1. <u>Desire</u>: desires are normal but must be mastered
 - 2. <u>Deception</u>: the bait that attracts us and hides the hook
 - 3. <u>Disobedience</u>: when the temptation becomes an act of our will
 - 4. <u>Death</u>: the end result of sin

II. The Goodness of God

- A. Trial and Hardship leave us vulnerable to doubt
- B. 4 Facts of God's Goodness:
 - 1. God only gives good gifts
 - 2. The way God gives is good
 - 3. God gives constantly
 - 4. God does not change
